## **Fly Non-Stop between Massena and Boston via Boutique Air**

Massena Town Supervisor Steve O'Shaughnessy announced today that the first weekend of flights offered between Massena International Airport (MSS) to Boston Logan International Airport (BOS) was successful.



In March of this year, after hearing from members of the public and having a discussion with Boutique Air, the Massena Town Council agreed to send a letter to the US Department of Transportation's Essential Air Program supporting Boutique Air's request to offer flights between Massena, NY and Boston, MA. The DOT approved the request and the new nonstop flights began Friday, June 1, 2018.

Massena Town Supervisor, Steve O'Shaughnessy stated, "On behalf of the Town of Massena, we are very excited to have this nonstop route that will connect Massena to Boston. Our experiences with previous destinations (Albany, NY and Baltimore, MD) were positive, but Boston has the additional connectivity options that prove more beneficial to our area travelers. The comfortable facilities, professional staff and free airport parking, make utilizing Massena International Airport for your journey pleasant, affordable, and convenient."

The Massena International Airport, also known as Richards Field, is a public airport located 2 miles east of Massena, New York, minutes from the international bridge crossing at Cornwall. The airport offers commuter air service through Boutique Air, with 3 direct flights daily to Boston Logan Airport and connections to major destinations beyond. Owned and operated by the Town of Massena, the airport covers over 475 acres with two runways and serves as a U.S. Customs Port of Entry for planes entering the United States from Canada or other foreign countries.
